# *Woodswomen First At National Meet*

The Dartmouth Woodsmen's teams traveled to UNH this weekend for the 29th annual intercollegiate woodsmen's meet, with the women's team highlighting the competition for Dartmouth, taking first place among the six women's teams.

The men's teams did not fare as well, with the B team finishing 8th and the A team finishing 10th. However, Dartmouth men did have many strong individual showings.

Dartmouth's most impressive event was its sweep of the axe throw. Kim Rosenau took first place, Steve Pacala second, and Steve Thompson third.

Chris Mumford and Steve McKeever won the scoot load event. They also paired up to take second place in the combined time for singles canoeing.

In two-man canoeing, Pacala and George Kendrick finished second while Chuck Conte and Thompson were third. Conte also placed second in the chain throw event.

Despite torrents of rain, Dan Henke and Ted Boucher took second place in fire-building.

On their way to victory, the women also won several individual events. As a team they took the bucksawing event and the packboard relay. Rosenau had three individual titles, winning the axe throw, and then teaming up with Lex Bond to take doubles canoeing and fire-building.

Cay Wieboldt and Stacey Miller won the felling competition and Wieboldt went on to take the chain throw event.

With the competition over, the Big Green teams can look forward to the 1977 intercollegiate meet which will be held at Dartmouth next spring.
