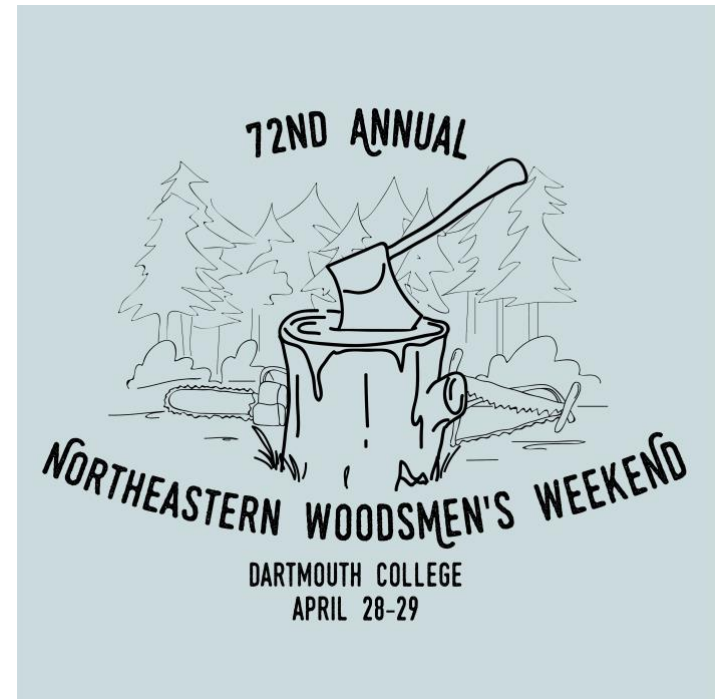
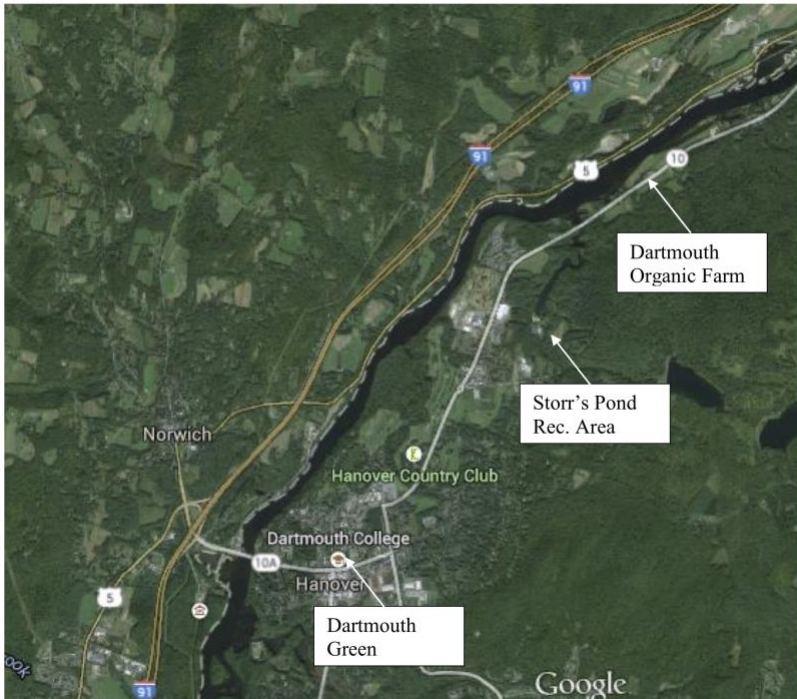


Maps for Dartmouth Woodsmen's Weekend 2018

The Dartmouth Woodsmen's team and the Dartmouth Outing Club are proud to host the 72nd annual Woodsmen's Weekend here, in Hanover, New Hampshire. Northeastern collegiate woodsmen's competitions started nearly three quarters of a century ago, as a way of paying homage to the long history of logging in New England. Ross McKenney (1890-1971), woodcraft advisor to the college, started the Woodsmen's weekend here in 1947 as a way for students to display and then pass along the fun and craft of using tools such as axes, saws, peaveys, and more.

This weekend, students from 14 schools across New England will be competing in 19 different events in the hope of claiming woodsmen's glory! Watch as students display such traditional forestry techniques as chopping, sawing, and splitting our locally-sourced, Northeastern wood.
