WOODSMEN WEEKEND

"Ou est St. Anne?" was the rallying cry this winter for the twelve hearty woodsmen who represented Dartmouth in the 16th Annual Woodsmen Tournament at MacDonald College in Montreal. The competition was run with the same organizational skill people have come to expect of the large 33 team tournament.

The sixteen events that comprised the competition covered a broad range of woods and outdoor skills. While the Dartmouth teams both demonstrated significant improvement over last year's results, neither team was able to win any of the events although both had several outstanding performances.

The highlight of the competition for the Dartmouth teams was the second place finish by the B team's Bill Paganelli '78 in the mile and a half snowshoe race. The A team demonstrated its skill and strength by placing third in the log roll, scoring 94 out of a possible 100 points. Excellent performances were also recorded in the chain throw by the A team's Gary Clohan '77 and B team captain Neil Van Dyke '76, placing third and fifth in that event.

The renewed and enthusiastic interest in the competition promises an even better performance in this year's spring meet at UNH. With the addition of a women's team for that competition team captain Oleh Haluszka '77 and all involved are looking forward to better performances and continued good fun in the future.
